The Granby Land Trust invites artists to submit original work, including but not limited to painting, photography, printmaking, drawing, and sculpture, to its tenth annual juried art show, to be held October 29 – November 29, 2015, at the Lost Acres Vineyard Gallery in North Granby, CT.

Works should be inspired by New England's natural beauty. All genres of visual art are encouraged, including but not limited to landscapes, botanicals, still-lives, portraits, and abstract art.

Artists are asked to identify 1) the property or place that inspired their work; and 2) the town and state in which the property is located (must be located in New England: CT, RI, MA, VT, NH, ME). New this year: properties do not have to be preserved to be eligible. All

works will be juried for entry and awards. Some awards carry stipulations. (For example, to be considered for the Granby Land Trust Award, the work must be inspired by a Granby Land Trust property.) Please see the list of awards for further stipulations.

2D artists are limited to **(2) entries - 40 inches or smaller** on any side. **Size limit includes all frames and mats.** Painted edge canvases are okay. Please have your work wired and ready for hanging. No saw tooth hangers or clip mountings will be accepted.

3D artists are limited to **(2) entries**. Free-standing art must stand on a base of no greater than 18" x 18" and be no taller than 6'. Sculpture on pedestals must sit on a pedestal no bigger than 18" x 18". Please provide your own pedestals. Jewelry or similar items must include a presentation case or display, and consist of no more than **(2) entries per artist**.

ENTERING YOUR WORK:

Entry Pre-Registration: Save \$5 by **pre-registering** your entries. Simply mail your registration form, with payment, by October 21 (see Registration Form below).

Entry Fees: A non-refundable fee of **\$25** is charged for one entry, and **\$35** for two entries **pre-registered by mail**. For **drop-off day entries, we will charge \$30 for one entry and \$40 for two**. Please make checks payable to "Granby Land Trust."

Drop-Off Dates: Friday, October 23, from 11:00AM to 2:00PM and Saturday, October 24, from 9:00AM until 12:00PM.

What You Need To Bring:

1. Your work.
2. Completed entry forms and entry fee.

Notification: A list of accepted entries will be posted on the GLT website (www.granbylandtrust.org) under the Events Listing for the Art Show (this is located in the "Events Calendar" section).

Pick-Up Date for Declined Works: Saturday, October 31, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM at Lost Acres Vineyard.

Artists' Paint Out: Sunday, October 4, Broad Hill Road Corridor -- Meet at Put and Nannie Brown's home at 16 Broad Hill Road, West Granby. Paint-out will start at 8AM; complimentary continental breakfast will be available. The general public will be invited to walk area from 10:30 - 12:30PM to see the artists' progress.

Opening Reception: Thursday, October 29, Lost Acres Vineyard, from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Awards will be presented at the Opening.

Art Talk (New this Year): Thursday, November 12, Lost Acres Vineyard, from 7 PM to 9 PM, co-hosted by Laura Eden and Bill Simpson. Join us for a casual gathering with light refreshments, at which a number of artists will discuss their works and the inspirations behind them.

Pick-up Dates for Accepted Works: Sunday, November 29, from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM and Monday, November 30, from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

Sales: All work must be available for sale. 60% of sales will be returned to the artist with the remainder of the proceeds to benefit the Granby Land Trust and to support the event.

THE JUROR:

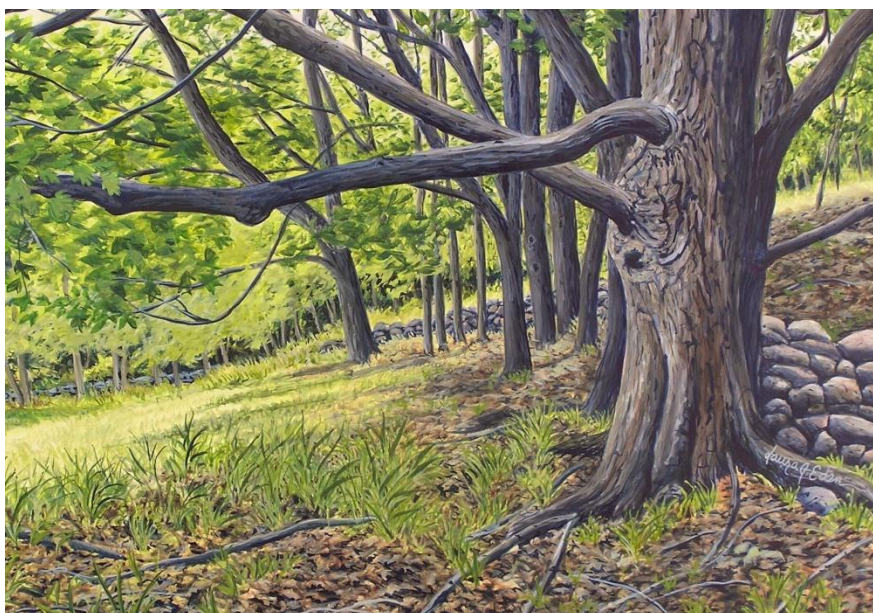
