Entries must be original work, including but not limited to painting, photography, printmaking, drawing, and sculpture and should highlight the beauty and importance of conserved lands (those lands whose ownership or development rights are owned by a Land Trust, the State, the Town, private land conservation organizations such as McLean Game Refuge, the Nature Conservancy, etc.). There are no restrictions on location of property; however, artists must identify 1) the name of the property that inspired their work; 2) the town in which the property is located; and 3) the conservation organization that protects the property. (For example: Mary Edwards Mountain Property/North Granby, CT/Granby Land Trust.) All works will be juried for entry and awards.

2D artists are limited to **(2) entries - 36 inches or smaller on** any side. *Limit does not include frames or mats. Painted edge canvases are OK.* Please have your work wired and ready for hanging. No saw tooth hangers or clip mountings will be accepted.

3D artists are limited to **(2) entries**. Free-standing art must stand on a base of no greater than 18" x 18" and be no taller than 6'. Sculpture on pedestals must sit on a pedestal no bigger than 18" x 18". Please provide your own pedestals. Jewelry or similar items must include a presentation case or display, and consist of no more than **(2) entries per artist**.

ENTERING YOUR WORK:

New This Year - Entry Pre-Registration: Save \$5 by **pre-registering** your entries. Simply mail your registration form, with payment, by October 22 (see Registration Form below).

Entry Fees: A non-refundable fee of **\$25** is charged for **one entry**, and **\$35** for **two entries pre-registered by mail**. For **drop-off day entries**, we will charge **\$30 for one entry and \$40 for two**. Please make checks payable to "Granby Land Trust."

Drop Off Dates: Friday, October 24, from 11:00AM to 2:00PM and Saturday, October 25, from 9:00AM until 12:00PM.

What You Need To Bring:

1. Your work.
2. Completed entry forms and entry fee (if you pre-registered, you only need to bring "Drop Off" forms).

Notification: A list of accepted entries will be posted on the GLT website (www.granbylandtrust.org) under the Events Listing for the Art Show (this is located in the "Events Calendar" section).

Declined Work: Please pick up on Saturday, November 1, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM at Lost Acres Vineyard.

Opening Reception: Thursday, October 30, Lost Acres Vineyard, from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Awards will be presented at the Opening.

Pick-up Date: Sunday, November 30, from 2:00 PM to 5:00 PM and Monday, December 1, from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

Sales: All work must be available for sale. 60% of sales will be returned to the artist with the remainder of the proceeds to benefit the Granby Land Trust and to support the event.

THE JUROR: **Amy Kurtz Lansing** has been Curator at the Florence Griswold Museum in Old Lyme, CT, since 2006. A graduate of Smith College, Kurtz Lansing received an M.A. and M.Phil. in the History of Art from Yale University. She has organized or co-organized an array of exhibitions, including Call of the Coast: Art Colonies of New England; Stickwork: Patrick Dougherty's The Rambles; Visions of Mood: Henry C. White Pastels; and Historical Fictions: Edward Lamson Henry's Paintings of Past and Present, which appeared at the Yale University Art Gallery and at the New York Historical Society. Before coming to the Florence Griswold Museum, Kurtz Lansing worked in the Department of American Paintings and Sculpture at the Yale University Art Gallery.

"Celebrating Preserved Lands" is a juried art show which celebrates the work of those individuals and organizations that forever preserve the beautiful and important natural spaces that improve our quality of life, encourage our appreciation of nature, and provide havens for wildlife and fauna to thrive.

The Granby Land Trust: The Granby Land Trust works to preserve Granby's natural heritage through the conservation of its scenic vistas, open space corridors, waterways, wildlife habitat, ecologically sensitive areas, and agricultural land.
