**Our Goal:** *This year we are staging a show of smaller scale works, so we can display more work from more artists. We ask that all 2D artists deliver their works unframed, except those that require glass for protection, such as watercolor, pastel, and photography. In the cases where glass is required we ask that those artists use simple metal frames that match the dimensions of the canvases that will be accepted - 12"x12" or 18"x18". From the painters we ask that wrap-around canvases be used (without staples showing) and that the artist paint the edges of the canvas - in whatever manner they choose. Please have your work wired and ready for hanging. No saw tooth hangers or clip mountings will be accepted.*

**Entries must be original 2 or 3 dimensional work, including but not limited to painting, photography, drawing, and sculpture and should be inspired by a part of Granby that you wish to preserve. You will be asked on the entry form to designate the location in Granby that inspired you. All works will be juried for entry and awards.**

2D artists are limited to: **(3) 12" x 12" entries, or (2) 18" x 18", or (1) 12" and (1) 18"**.

3D artists are limited to **(2) entries**. Free standing art must stand on a base of no greater than 18" x 18" and be no taller than 6'. Sculpture on pedestals must sit on a pedestal no bigger than 18" x 18". Please provide your own pedestals. Jewelry or similar items must include a presentation case or display, and consist of no more than **(3) entries per artist**.

A **non-refundable fee of \$20** is charged for **one entry, \$25 for two, and \$30 for three**. Artists over 60 pay a fee discounted by \$5 in each category. Please make checks payable to "Granby Land Trust."

**About Juror Patricia Carrigan**

Patricia Carrigan of East Granby, CT is a painter and mixed media artist, and Instructor of Drawing in the Visual Fine Arts Department at Manchester Community College in Manchester, CT.

Patricia has exhibited her paintings, drawings, and mixed media work in national and international exhibitions since 1990, and is represented in many private and public collections. Ms. Carrigan received her Master of Fine Arts degree from the University of Connecticut at Storrs in 1994 in painting and drawing and a Bachelor of Arts degree from Hartwick College in Oneonta, New York in 1982, in studio art and art education. Themes explored throughout her work include memory and personal storytelling, Irish family histories and folklore, and everyday symbols.

Patricia has been the recipient of numerous grants including a 2002 and 2004 Individual Artist Fellowship Grant from The Connecticut Commission on Culture and Tourism and a Balliglen Artist Residency Fellowship in Ballycastle, County Mayo, Ireland in 2005 and in 2007.
