**Entries must be original work, including but not limited to painting, photography, printmaking, drawing, and sculpture and should be inspired by a scenic location in the Farmington Valley ( Avon, Canton, Farmington, Granby, E. Granby, Simsbury, New Hartford etc. ). You will be asked on the entry form to designate the location that inspired you. All works will be juried for entry and awards.**

**2D** artists are limited to **(2) entries - 24 inches or smaller on any side**. *Limit does not include frames or mats. Painted edge canvases are OK.* Please have your work wired, framed, and ready for hanging. No saw tooth hangers or clip mountings will be accepted.

**3D** artists are limited to **(2) entries**. Free - standing art must stand on a base of no greater than 18" x 18" and be no taller than 6'. Sculpture on pedestals must sit on a pedestal no bigger than 18" x 18". Please provide your own pedestals. Jewelry or similar items must include a presentation case or display, and consist of no more than **(2) entries per artist**.

A **non-refundable fee of \$20** is charged **for one entry**, and **\$25 for two**. Artists over 60 pay a fee discounted by \$5 in each category. Please make checks payable to "Granby Land Trust."

**About Juror John J. Lo Presti**

My primary subject of "landscape" has a 500-year-old tradition in Western art. It is obvious that is no longer possible to make traditional landscapes as an avant garde activity. However I can draw on the tradition without slavishly copying it. The earliest landscape painters were interested primarily in tone and chiaroscuro. The whole approach to color changed in the twentieth century, and my antecedents drew upon researches into pure color relations. My approach is affected by this more recent reworking of traditional landscape painting. My work does not just repeat the past; I draw from tradition but use my sensibility to create new images. I try to capture the strength of the old by using new tools.
