### Entry Requirements

Entries must be **original work, painted, drawn or photographed from the Granby Land Trust's Mary Edwards Mountain Property or The Godard Preserve in Granby, CT.** Work not originating from these locations will not be accepted. For a map and directions to these preserves, visit [www.GranbyLandTrust.org](http://www.GranbyLandTrust.org).

Entries submitted for the Granby's Natural Landscape show will be **juried for entry and prizes.**

**Dates & Location of Exhibition:** November 2 through November 30, 2006 at J. Vallee Brunelle Fine Art and Framing, 10 Hartford Avenue, Granby, CT.

**Opening Reception:** Thursday, November 2, at J. Vallee Brunelle from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Prizes will be awarded at that time.

Each artist is limited to **2 entries.** A non-refundable fee of \$20 is charged for one entry, \$30 for two entries. Seniors over 60 and members of the Granby Land Trust, Granby Artists Association or Holcomb Farm pay a discounted fee of \$15 and \$25 respectively. Make checks payable to "Granby Land Trust".

**Drop-off Dates:** At J. Vallee Brunelle Fine Art and Framing, on **Saturday, October 21** from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM and **Monday, October 23** from Noon until 2:00 PM.

Work must be suitably framed and wired for wall hanging. **Size must not exceed 36" on any side.** Any work not meeting these specifications will not be accepted.

A completed entry form must accompany each entry, along with a **(SASE)** self-addressed, stamped envelope.

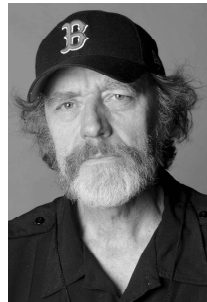
**Work not selected for the show** must be picked-up on Saturday, October 28 from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM at J. Vallee Brunelle.

**Sales:** All work must be available for sale. 60% of sales will be returned to the artist with the remainder of the proceeds going to support the event and the Granby Land Trust.

### About Juror Stephen Brown

The Granby Land Trust, the Granby Artists Association, and Holcomb Farm Learning Centers are proud to have Stephen Brown as our juror. Originally from Greeley, Colorado, Stephen Brown is now a full-time resident of New England, and by all appearances a Red Sox fan. Mr. Brown is a tenured member of the painting faculty at the University of Hartford (CT). He is a recipient of the Academy Award for Painting from the American Academy of Arts and Letters (NY) and of the Benjamin Altman Award for landscape from the National Academy of Design (NY). Mr. Brown has also twice received the Coffin Grant, a competitive grant awarded to a member of the University of Hartford faculty. The 1994 winner of the Academy Award in Art at the American Academy of Arts and Letters, Brown was elected to the National Academy of Design in 2000.

His work is represented in the permanent collections of numerous museums throughout the United States, including the Hofstra Museum, Hempstead, NY; The Speed Museum, Louisville, KY; The New Britain Museum of American Art, New Britain, CT and most recently the Springfield Museum of Fine Art, in Springfield MA.
