Entry Requirements

Entries must be **original 2 or 3 dimensional work inspired by a water scene in Granby, CT**, and will be juried for entry and awards. Suggested Granby water locations, including maps and descriptions, may be found at GranbyLandTrust.org or contact Rosemarie Mendes at ramusic@cox.net or **860.653.0566**

Each artist is limited to **2 entries**. A non-refundable fee of \$20 is charged for one entry, \$30 for two entries. Artists over 60 pay a discounted fee of \$15 and \$25 respectively. Please make checks payable to "Granby Land Trust".

2-D work must be framed and securely wired for hanging. No saw tooth hangers or clip mountings will be accepted.

Size must not exceed 36" in either direction. 3-D work must be freestanding or mounted to be freestanding. Please include your own pedestal if needed. Size must not exceed 24" in width or depth, 60" in height or 50 lbs. in weight. Jewelry must include a presentation case or display of some kind. *Any work not meeting these specifications will not be accepted.*

A completed entry form must accompany each entry, along with a **self-addressed, stamped envelope**. Additional entry forms can be found at GranbyLandTrust.org.

Declined Work: Must be picked-up on Saturday, November 1, from 11:00AM to 3:00PM at J. Vallee Brunelle.

Opening Reception: Thursday, November 6, at J. Vallee Brunelle from 5:00PM to 8:00PM. Awards will be presented at that time.

Sales: All work must be available for sale. 60% of sales will be returned to the artist with the remainder of the proceeds to benefit the Granby Land Trust and to support the event.

About Juror Walter Hall

We are honored to have Walter Hall, Associate Professor of Ceramics at the Hartford Art School as our juror this year. Mr. Hall holds a BA in Fine Arts from Haverford College and an MFA in ceramics from the University of Massachusetts, and has been a full time faculty member since 1976.

Mr. Hall has been honored with solo exhibitions at The Clay Studio in Philadelphia, Haverford College, the College of William and Mary, and the Paul Mellon Arts Center at Choate-Rosemary Hall, among others. His work has been included in many invitational and group exhibitions throughout the country, including "Yankee Clay: Ceramic Artists of the Northeast" at the Slater Museum; the "27th Ceramic National" at the Everson Museum (NY), the American Craft Museum (NYC); and the Smithsonian Institution. Hall's work has been cited in numerous books on contemporary ceramics, including: *The Craft and Art of Clay* by Susan Peterson, *The New Ceramics* by Peter Dormer, and *Finding One's Way With Clay* by Paulus Berensohn, and in leading journals of ceramic art.

A Special Thanks: Walter Hall has graciously refused any stipend for jurying our show, so the Granby Land Trust chose to create an award in Mr. Hall's name.
