The Granby Land Trust invites artists to submit original work, including but not limited to painting, photography, printmaking, drawing, and sculpture, to its 15th annual juried art show, to be held October 27 - November 27, 2022, at Lost Acres Vineyard Art Gallery in North Granby, CT.

Works should be inspired by New England's natural beauty. All mediums and methods will be accepted for consideration including but not limited to painting, collage, photography, sculpture, assemblages, fabric, clay, etching, etc.

Artists are asked to identify the property or place that inspired their work by name, town, and state. Only New England locations, please (CT, RI, MA, VT, NH, and ME). Some awards are specific to a particular place or subject matter. Please see awards list for details.

2D artists are limited to **(2) entries - 38 inches or smaller** on any side, including frame. Painted-edge canvases are acceptable. Please have your work wired and ready for hanging. No sawtooth hangers or clip mountings will be accepted.

3D artists are limited to **(2) entries**. Free-standing art must stand on a base of no greater than 18" x 18" and be no taller than 6'. Sculpture on pedestals must sit on a pedestal no bigger than 18" x 18". Please provide your own pedestals. Jewelry or similar items must include a presentation case or display.



ENTERING YOUR WORK:

Entry Pre-Registration: Save \$5 by **pre-registering** your entries. Simply mail your registration form, with payment, by October 14 (see Registration Form below).

Entry Fees: For entries **pre-registered by mail**, a non-refundable fee of **\$25** is charged for **one entry**, and **\$35** for **two entries**. For **drop-off day entries**, we will charge **\$30** for **one entry** and **\$40** for **two entries**. Please make checks payable to “Granby Land Trust.”

Drop-Off Dates: Friday, October 21, from 10:00AM to 2:00PM and Saturday, October 22, from 9:00AM to 12:00PM.

What You Need To Bring: 1.) Your work, with drop-off forms attached. 2.) Completed entry forms and entry fee, if you did not pre-register.

Notification: A list of accepted entries will be posted on the GLT website (www.granbylandtrust.org) under the “Events” tab on the page navigation bar and located on the “Art Show” pull down listing.

Pick-Up Date for Declined Works: Thursday, October 27 from **4:00 PM to 5:00 PM SHARP** (no exceptions – please understand that we are very busy that evening) or Friday, October 28, from **9:00 AM to 12:00 PM** at Lost Acres Vineyard.

Opening Reception: Thursday, October 27, Lost Acres Vineyard, from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Awards will be presented at the Opening.

Pick-up Dates for Accepted Works: Sunday, November 27, from 2:00 to 5:00 PM and Monday, November 29, from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

Sales: All work must be available for sale. 60% of sales will be returned to the artist with the remainder of the proceeds to benefit the Granby Land Trust and to support the event.
